ABSL2 Work in Progress PPE Required for Entry



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required for researchers when administering biological agents (including viruses, viral vectors, and bacteria). The indicated PPE is required when administering agents, handling materials, and for anyone entering within 72 hours after administration.

- Disposable/reusable gown or designated lab coat
- Double gloves
- Bouffant/hairnet*
- Shoe covers
- Face mask
- Safety glasses/goggles

*Bouffant/hairnet is not required for visitors during surgery or for animal care staff in this area within 72 hours after last viral vector administration.
