Before pursuing biological safety full-time, Dr. Condreay had a 28-year career as a pharmaceutical R&D scientist with GlaxoSmithKline working with a variety of pathogenic viruses and recombinant viral vector systems. Dr. Condreay has been involved in training and education efforts in biological safety for over 20 years.
